The first Zettle card reader is \$29.00, the second and following are \$79. The Zettle card reader is palm size, and charges with a micro USB cord. (Android phone charger. Charging cord included; short and sweet.) It connects to a mobile device via Bluetooth. The mobile device is logged into the PayPal account being used for the event, before the Zettle is connected.

**Cost to operate is on a per transaction basis:**

A mobile device is required to connect to the current PayPal Point of Sale (POS) System. (A laptop won't work, I checked.)

The mobile device must have the active memory to be able to connect to WiFi, and also support Bluetooth connections, while running the necessary applications for PayPal. Battery capacity is also critical, as we do so much away from electrical infrastructure. Durability, portability, and usability of equipment round out the assessment criteria.

**How We Use the Equipment:** Usability requires that the mobile device (smart phone or tablet) that works with the PayPal Point of Sale (POS) system also works with the MS 365 Office system used by the SCA. The Exchequer will need to be able to access their account on the device in order to do their job. Because of this, a tablet is preferred to a smart phone.

Because of the need to use MS 365, an Android tablet is preferred.

Because of the kind of work the Exchequer will be doing in MS 365, a peripheral full-size keyboard with a number pad, and a full size mouse is recommended for the gate kit.

The PayPal Gate Team will primarily be using the PayPal card reader, rather than interacting with the mobile device (tablet). Their usability requirements will primarily be battery / power maintenance, connectivity, and sanitary precautions.

**How We Could Use the Tablet:** The tablet will be able to handle Zoom meetings, it will be able to work with an external USB camera to Live Stream, it will be able to run MS 365, it will be able to do basic Live Stream Production tasks with Streamyard. (I double checked with Sindry / Emory, one of the two Kingdom Live Stream deputies, to make sure.)

**Compatibility** The Zettle Go app is free to download and runs on smartphones and tablets running iOS 12 or Android 8. The Zettle by PayPal Reader works with Bluetooth-enabled devices that run iOS 12 or Android 8. Check out our compatibility guide for more information. Internet connection and data usage For Zettle to work, you need to be connected to a 3G, 4G or Wifi network. These connections are much faster than the 2G technology relied on by traditional card terminals. Accepting payments with the Zettle Go app only takes a few kilobytes of data. However, we recommend all Zettle users connect to a stable network with a reliable connection

#### **What We Should Look at Buying Later:**

- • A Bluetooth full sized keyboard. As the Exchequer won't be using MS 365 while the Zettle is connected, this is the best connectivity for a full sized keyboard.
- • A USB mouse, and /or a Bluetooth mouse. (The recommended tablet comes with a stylus pen, that and the touch screen will back up the mouse, but there's really nothing better than a full size mouse when dealing with 365.)
- • A second battery for the tablet.
- • Charging devices for outside events without electrical stuff.
- • Backup micro usb chargers, preferably ones with large, flexible cords, and a three head charger option. (Micro, C, and iOS).
- • A Zettle Dock 2 for indoor events, currently \$53.90 with tax. <https://shop.zettle.com/us/zettle-dock-2>
- • A durable, hard activity carrier for the equipment, preferably in backpack form.
- • An external USB camera for Live Stream use.
- • A tripod for the external camera.
- • A USB microphone for when the tablet is being used for Zoom.
- • A number type system for line management. (Maybe design is a better idea than purchase.)
- • Line canopy / shelter for outdoor line management.
- UVC cash and paper boxes, possibly wands, for contagion management

Please talk this up with your friends outside of the Barony as well. Now that we have given Summits first chance to volunteer to do the AS&S displays, we will soon ask Kingdom wide.

### **Birthday Bash report, Wulfric: April 15<sup>th</sup> 2023,**

Primary site is Pleasant Hill Lutheran Church (the Yule site), with Murchadh's property (Birthday Bash 2022 site) as an alternate. Will be set up by the Sergeantry, Wulfric will be Event Steward under Murchadh's guidance. Proposed budget is \$200. The three sergeantry candidates need to work together to make it happen. Voted and approved last month with unanimous support.

### **Egil's Tourney report, Hrodnavar Hakonson:** Steward/Advisor Emeritus: Yseult of Broceliande

**Date:** May 26 – 29, 2023 (Memorial Day weekend for 2023, 2024 and 2025 have been posted to the Kingdom calendar) **Location:** Lynx Hollow Park, Creswell, OR

**Progress to date:** Overall, group efforts are on the slow burner since the Barony needs to focus on 12<sup>th</sup> Night planning. I will start up regular group meetings in January.

Some of the 2022 staff have re-upped for next year. So far I have people lined up for Merchants, Land Allocation, and Pre-reg, in addition to the Baronial officers who will be serving in their roles. I will fill a few more spaces next month.

**Three Pillars:** Dame Yseult will be organizing the competition. As she is Steward of 12<sup>th</sup> Night, we'll hear more about this in February.

**Prizes:** A few are in the works, I am working on getting more commitments. Alan Bowyer has promised several items. (Joyful Noise!!)

**For site tokens** I have an idea to cast replica Viking-era coins. I will determine in a month or so if this is feasible. Pewter would be easy to work, but is expensive for the quantity we'd need. Aluminum is attractive since the raw material is cheap. If we go this route, I already have agreement from Aila'ntha to use A&S meetings as work parties.

Dame Yseult has published an inventory of the Baronial pavilions, and recommended that one more would be useful for Egils. With this in mind, I have purchased a used 10x14 Panther pavilion, complete with sides, poles, ropes, etc for \$1500. After 12<sup>th</sup> Night, if the Barony is in good financial position, I will offer it to the Barony at that price. If the Barony decides not to take it, then I will likely sell it.

It will be our intention to have PayPal available at gate. We will have had it at Yule and 12<sup>th</sup> Night .

## **OFFICERS' REPORTS**

**Arts & Sciences Aila'ntha of William's Keep:** A&S is now holding meetings on alternate Sunday afternoons to better accommodate the shorter fall days and family scheduling. We will continue to meet in hybrid meetings, which are still attended well with in person locals as well as consistently hosting guests from kingdoms afar.

Our scheduled meetings through the rest of 2022 are currently fully schedules with activities. The first three months of 2023 are also filling quickly. Due to the upcoming holiday season, I will not be adding extra meetings to accommodate requested classes until after the new year.

**Chamberlain, Yseult of Broceliande:** I have not done anything in the past two months as I was out of town and then recovering from covid. In the next week or two I will be inventorying the tablecloths, table runners, and wall hangings so that the Stewards for Yule know what we have available. Then I will inventory items that will be needed for 12<sup>th</sup> Night. Next up will be materials, including pavilions for Egil's Tourney. We still need to get the ripped pavilion repaired and find poles for the new pavilion donated by Sir Alail.

**Chatelaine, Johanna Trewpeny:** The month of October was relatively quiet -- the smoke didn't help. Some of our newest people came to Archery and Arts and Sciences. I encourage newcomers to come to Scribal night as Tori/Gillian is helpful and encouraging. All levels of skill are welcome!

Several online contacts and working with people to get their names and heraldry registered. Thanks to Cormac Mor for his gracious assistance. Business cards have yet to be ordered. Tokens started for Yule.

**Chronicler, Yseult:** Many thanks to HL Emma Haldane for taking minutes at the September Council when I was sick. Those minutes have been posted to the Baronial web page and the Baronial Facebook chat group Files section.

I will be publishing the fourth and last BiCranial Bear of the year around November 1. The lead article will Emma's, about how to register for the Baronial Polling. The rest will likely focus on our upcoming Yule and hosting of An Tir 12<sup>th</sup> Night 2023. If you wish to submit an article for the Bear, I would love to see it!

**Exchequer, Asgerdr Audsdottir:** Bank balance on 23 Oct. 2023 was \$13,906.11. Currently we have \$1,370 in merchants fees for 12<sup>th</sup> Night. We will need to pay \$1,500.00 more to the hotel. No out-of-the-ordinary expenses are anticipated.

I do need approval for a budget increase from \$180 to \$200 for the storage unit. Rent for it increased \$20/month as of March 1, 2022. Passed.

Officer budget requests are due to Asgerd by Nov. 15, 2022. She will present a proposed budget at November Council. We vote on the budget at December Council.

Bank signatures: We need to update the signature card. Murchadh needs to be added, Godwyn taken off. The remainder (me, Yseult, Principality Deputy Exchequer) will be retained.

PayPal equipment: Emma has produced a detailed proposal, which will be discussed with the Seneschal, Coronet, and users. The expense has been discussed and approved at prior meetings. I will be attending Principality-level training and preparing a list of people for gate and PayPal volunteers.

I need Gate Stewards and/or volunteers for Yule, 12<sup>th</sup> Night, and Egils. Please contact me if interested.

**Gold Key, Helen Louise Gaskyn:** Gold key helped 3 families and 5 individuals make garb this month. Loaned 4 people garb for events which was received back, cleaned, and put back in stock. Received garb and fabric donation from Raven and Vesta. Also received trim donation from Marion Alter. Reorganized Key into smaller and easier to lift containers with the help of Dame Johanna. Helped Murchod with preparations for Yule event.

**Herald, Durin:** There have been no herald activities this month. My tenure as Baronial Herald has come to its end, so the Office is now open for another to step into.

**Lists, Acacia:** Not present, no report.

### **Marshals**

**Archery, Alan Bowyer:** We have lost out on many of our practices due to poor air quality. I had hoped for an extended archery season. What I got was an extended fire season. Range will probably be closed by next month.

**Armored Combat, Tati Sigurdsson:** There were two practices with little fighting due to poor air quality. A couple of new folks showed up, interested in fighting. Hrodnavar has a couple of helmets to donate as loaners.

**Cut & Thrust:** office is vacant

**Rapier, Hauk Bjarnarson:** No comments, questions, or concerns. There have been no injuries in the past month. The Light Armor Experiment is underway, and those of us participating are submitting appropriate reports after each practice.

**Thrown Weapons, Murchadh Monaidh Chroaibhe:** Practices have been held alternating Tuesdays with A&S, 5:00 – 7:00pm, and alternating Saturdays 9:00am – 12:00pm, at the Dexter Range, and are coordinated with Archery practices as weather allows. Practices are also adjusted so as not to conflict with Summits Events.

Practices have been well attended eight to twelve people. Scores have been reported and no injuries or accidents have occurred.

The Baronial Trailer is located in Dexter. All hitch and door locks are on the trailer and Murchadh has custody of the keys.

Thrown Weapons is set up both in the barn and outside adjacent to the archery range in Dexter.

**Youth Armored Combat:** office is vacant

**Scribe, Gillian FitzGilbert:** Greetings. I am about half way through painting the charters for Yule, and I have several pieces out with some very helpful and talented members of our Barony. Scribal nights continue, happening every other week. I'm also in the beginning stages of developing an "intro to scribal night" class for an A&S meeting, in the hope that people who are intimidated but interested will feel more comfortable pursuing scribal activities.

**Seneschal, Murchadh Monaidh Chroaibhe:** It has been a busy first month in my second term as Seneschal. After transferring the e-mail account and coordinating with the Kingdom Polling Deputy we have our Candidates accepted by the Crown, two hybrid Meet & Greets scheduled, and the timeline set for polling and selection of Heirs. One critical component is having individual accounts on the Kingdom website. Please go to: [Login – Kingdom of An Tir](#) to confirm you have an account. If you do not have an account, go to: [Register – Kingdom of An Tir](#) to create one. When polling opens, you will need to go to the Kingdom website, log in, and provide your input to the Crown. The new system allows you to go in and edit your responses until polling closes.

The last critical piece of transition is the Bank Signature Card, which I will coordinate with the Exchequer to update.

I've been in contact with the State Parks and am exploring options to strengthen our relationship with them to ensure our long-term relationship, ensuring Lynx Hollow Park improvements and availability without being priced-out. I hope to have a proposal before the populace by the end of the year.



As the Social Media Officer is a direct report to the Seneschal, I will include that information in my report until the position is filled.



## 12<sup>th</sup> Night 2023. Report to Kingdom Curia as of October 19, 2022

Event Stewards are Mistress Yseult of Broceliande and the Honorable Emma Haldane.

Emma continued to be the lead person working on the event this past quarter while Yseult was in Europe and then recovering from covid.

**Room reservations and problems:** The hotel made the room reservation link live a day before we asked (and they agreed, in writing). People who were on the open to all Zoom Q&A for registration process followed the instructions Emma gave to open the reservation link in a browser tab to get ready for the anticipated going live at 8pm on the 8<sup>th</sup>. (These were the same written instructions available on the Calendar Page, FB, and Discord.)

Much to everyone's surprise, instead of the "trial run", the link was alive. Once made, the reservations couldn't be cancelled without losing rooms for 12<sup>th</sup> Night. The 10 people there understood the problem and did not tell their friends in advance.

No manager was available at 9 PM. By the time our sales rep was due in her at 9am, all of the rooms were booked. People getting their tab ready for 8 p.m. (again, as instructed) as their day started, discovered the link was live, many assuming that the hotel had swapped 8am for 8pm. The reaction to reserve and tell friends was understandable, and impossible to prevent.

Emma decided that there was no way to tell everyone not to register until planned that would actually reach everyone. There was no calling it back, only trying to mitigate the situation as much as possible, such as creating and randomizing a wait list for people who also followed instructions, only to find they had no chance at booking. This was possible because of the support and assistance of

the Kingdom Seneschal, and the overriding good will and understanding of the citizens of An Tir and its Friends.

Those wait list requests have been randomized and Emma has emailed everyone on it so that they know their number on the wait list. Historically, there have not been room cancellations until late December as people get sick, run out of money, or have family or other conflicts arise that force them to cancel. Rooms may be released earlier this year, as people adjust their reservations, and double up, etc. We will put people into the cancelled rooms off the waiting list until the hotel enters its no refund reservation period. (We're currently persuading the hotel to extend this time period well into January. Given their error, we anticipate being able to be very persuasive.)

We have talked with other hotels about offering a block of rooms as a back-up hotel, but have either been turned down or offered \$329 rooms with a 100% attrition clause (which, of course, we refused).

This hotel issue did not and does not effect the reservations for Crowns, Principality Coronets, Great Officers, Champions, Vigilants, and Merchants. We are in planning contact with the head of retinues for The Crown, The Heirs, the Principality Coronets of Summits, and are on active standby to connect with the Tir Right Coronets in November.

We have contacted all of the officers and champions about whether they need a room for the event and have heard back from all but 3 people. We have also contacted the Crown, Heirs, and the Prince/Princess of Summits and Tir Right and their Retinue Coordinators about rooming arrangements, but we have not yet heard back from all them. (Great Western War is likely why.)

We have suites available for each Royal couple (\$300 + 11% tax per night) or we can use regular hotel rooms with two queen beds, but we will not be able to finalize any room arrangements until we know what the various Royalty want. Unless a Royal does not want a suite, all of the suites are spoken for.

**Hotel Arrangements:** We met with the hotel in August and discussed with the chef the plans for the Friday (Roman) and Saturday (Renaissance) evening buffet meals for the event. We will be meeting with the hotel in the next week or so to discuss what the chef has come up with and set up preliminary room use details for the meetings, etc. within the event. We will need to know the Crown and Heirs' schedule for Courts before we can finalize the room use orders with the hotel. We are still waiting to hear from some officers and groups as to whether they want to schedule a meeting at 12<sup>th</sup> Night. (We have sent out two rounds of emails asking about this, so anticipate receiving responses soon.)

**Finances:** We made our \$3000 payment to Valley River Inn in August. Our final site fee payment of \$1500 is due 13 December. Expenses incurred after that date will be paid after the event, though we do not anticipate any.

**Gate:** Emma has put together a proposal for our Exchequer and Baronial Council about what we need to purchase in order to handle PayPal at 12<sup>th</sup> Night. We will need to train some of our people and identify others from around the Kingdom to handle the PayPal payments at 12<sup>th</sup> Night. We hope to pilot the system at our Yule event on 17 December. (Emma will be taking the training.) Mauera Kethin has volunteered to handle scheduling Gate helpers for Friday and Saturday.

**Communication and Publicity:** We are updating the event's official information page (the An Tir Calendar Event page) regularly, as well as the event's Unofficial Facebook page and the unofficial An

Tir Discord server event channel. The event email is checked at least twice a day, and people typically get an answer within 12-24 hours, frequently sooner.

**Live Streaming:** Live Stream at 12<sup>th</sup> Night is being run by An Tir Live Stream Kingdom Deputies, Maire Blakater and Sindri inn hárfagri. They are part of the event staff, and are included in all planning sessions and in the unofficial planning group on Facebook. We're swinging into volunteer recruitment and training with them.

**Merchants:** So far we have requests for 27 of the 27 spaces available. As of this writing, we are waiting on payment from three merchants; the deadline is Nov. 1. After that date we can assign the hotel rooms we set aside for merchants and determine whether we have any extras.

**Vigils:** There are five vigils happening at 12<sup>th</sup> Night. All the vigilants have suites and a room for their wrangler.

**Saturday evening Italian Ball:** Dagrún Stjarna has agreed to act as hostess for the Ball and lead the dancing. Mistress Elizabeth Piper is organizing live music. We are still working on the details of the evening, but it will include a performance by the Commedia dell'Arte troupe, i'Falsari, a table decoration contest, and perhaps some Italian gaming. The hotel will provide a cash bar in the lobby.

**Decorations:** They are on schedule. We are doing a few more faux stained glass windows and several wall hangings for the Italian Ball.

**Other Activities:** We would like to hold a fighter practice for heavies and rapier / cut&thrust on Sunday morning, probably 10:30 – 12 (after the Curia meeting). What is the current policy on this? Does someone from Kingdom level organize it or should we have a local marshal run it?

We have had a request from Viscount Rapheal the Rogue (Robert Odekirk) to hold a 2 hour Harnischfechten tournament/demo at 12<sup>th</sup> Night, but we're not sure we have a time/place to schedule it if there is a Sunday morning fight practice and lots of meetings Saturday morning. (We're assuming court on Friday evening and Sunday all afternoon.)

Zahra bint al-Rammah, Shaykha of Aquaterra contacted us to reserve tables and a space for a silent auction, but we are waiting to hear further from her about details.

There will be live incidental music in the Main Lobby on Friday afternoon and evening, and possibly Saturday morning. (Live music will be a feature of the Italian Ball Saturday Night.)

The Arts & Sciences Display will be in the front part of the main lobby and the mezzanine area, and possibly part of the Live Stream feed.

The Merchants' Hall will be in the ballroom on the mezzanine level.

We are currently sending out publicity about a visit to the Burgess Collection of Medieval and Renaissance manuscripts at the University of Oregon Knight Library on Friday afternoon, 2:30 – 4

pm. This is a free event open to a dozen people who reserve a spot. We will arrange carpooling from the event hotel to campus and back.

We will have a St. Distaff Day spinning circle in the main lobby at some point.

There will be an Expats and Newcomers' Tea, probably late Saturday morning, maybe in the restaurant.

The Roman Baths will be available throughout the event. We already have at least two vigilants interested in reserving them and offers of classes on Roman culture.

At this point we have meeting requests from the An Tir Gardening Group, the Embellishers' Guild, the Kingdom Chatelaine, Marshals, and Heralds, plus the Finance Committee and Curia.

We are working on organizing a consulting heralds table, and hope to make it a Hybrid occurrence.

We look forward to working with the Crown and Heirs on the schedule. Once we know when Courts will occur, we can schedule the other activities around them.
