Hello,

The event went well. The Cut & Thrush championship list report has been sent in. It went well, though it did need to be pushed back due to few competitors. There were approximately 91 people through the gate. The baronial fundraiser earned \$399.25. We also received \$45 in donations. The Arts & Science displays were well received, as were the marshal displays. The day board went well and there were no issues. All of the classes were well attended and received high praise. The game boards were used by multiple people and 15 "thank you" cards were painted by the populace at the scribal table. The individual who was in charge of the Bardic could not show up, thankfully our Bardic champion stepped up and led a wonderful bardic including at least 2 dozen people. The person in charge of Gold Key could not run it because of family reasons, but thankfully our chatelaine and her deputy stepped up, Aila'ntha and Kaisa. Three new sergeants stepped up and one new candidate entered the trials.

Because this event is doing well, it appears as if we are out growing the site. This year weather allowed for people to go outside and watch the championship and for us to have a place for the marshal displays, but if the weather had been any worse people would have stayed inside and we would have not had room for the marshal displays or the championship. This site is great when the weather is good, but it is too small otherwise. We currently have a

good relationship with this site, so having another event at it could be good if good weather or fewer attendees were expected. Birthday Bash as an event often does not have good weather and has grown to have a large draw; thus a new site should be found for next year.

We have received 8 merchant applications so far. A&S is receiving teacher applications. The actual count will be left to Pam Perryman to report, as I know it has increased since we last spoke with her earlier last week on that.

We will be meeting with our Chamberlain soon to meet at the storage unit to do an inventory of supplies, prior to purchasing what will be needed for lands, parking, etc. for Egil's.

Two new 'pavilion' are being donated this week to the Barony for Egil's. One 10x20 popup identical to the blue one for use by A&S, and 1 10x20 carport style for use at gate.

## Cregil's 2026- Egil's 50!

We have confirmed that the Crown has received the May Crown Bid.

Cregil's will begin at 3pm on Sunday the weekend of Crown. It will end at 3pm on memorial day, as usual.

Parking and the Castravas, will this be an issue for the interweek?- Have charged \$500 for parking to Crown and the thought is to charge \$500 to Egils to cover the other days. We may be able to get away with parking more on site midweek as well, this is pending speaking to the park
