During the last month our Chatelaine signage, business cards, and flyers contributed to a demo put on by Briaroak in Roseburg on July 19th at the Spamalot play. As I was recovering from yet

another round of the current plague, Teresa of Adiantum and Katherine of The Lakes transported our materials and assisted Liadan of Seahaven with an SCA presence there. Others from our Barony also contributed their time by presenting fighting demos and meeting with the public.

I have prepped and organized the 5 day demo at the Lane County Fair from Wednesday July 23rd through Sunday July 27th. These were 4 twelve hour days and the last day was a 9 hour day, not including time spent setting up and tearing down.

This year's demo was twice the size as last year's due to removing ourselves from the Fiber Arts Division and moving to the Arts & Crafts Division of the vendor hall. With this additional space we were able to include the siege engine "Gryphons Rage" as well as overhead banner and wall hangings for photo opportunities for the fair attendees.

The results indicate this event was well worth our time and energy. We have already received 3 Newcomers Surveys, an email, and a friend request on Facebook, plus many new followers on our 2 Facebook pages. During this demo we had 19 contact cards filled out requesting us to contact them with follow-up.

Other connections made at the fair included conversation with a waiter from Sizzler who said they miss us holding our business meetings there and that they have a new owner who is planning improvements including improved air conditioning, a conversation with Victoria De Toledo, an Adiantumite from the 70s and 80s, and chatting with other former SCA attendees who are interested in becoming involved again.

This demo required a total of 21 people who were willing to bring their handcrafted items for display, set up the displays, offer demonstrations of crafts, explain the SCA and activities, pay exorbitant parking rates, set up and remove the displays, and give their time for the future of the Barony.
