Yseult sent initial publicity about Egils 2026 (without May Crown) to Adiantum, Summits and An Tir Facebook groups on or about Aug. 3 and sent updates for the event's website to the Adiantum Web Minister on Aug. 5 and 20. The overall publicity strategy will be to drive interest to the website as the best source for full information. We will, of course, keep the An Tir Calendar page updated as well.

As we all go to events, it is important that we all talk to as many people as possible about the pre-event camping week. September will be a good month for that – many events! We need to get folks interested in coming and in bringing activities that others can share. Let the committee know if we find someone who has an activity idea so that we can add it to our list of possibilities on the website and in our publicity. Bid for Midwinters-

The fire code limit in the main hall is 150, so even if we have much more attendance than anticipated it should be fine.

<u>March Coronet 2026-</u> This bid has not been submitted to the finance committee, so it can not be voted on tonight.

It has in the past been a day event, but it has also been a day event.

The site has flush, power, sinks. There is a parking fee of \$10 per vehicle. Would like to do a bread and soup feast with a potluck mid-day meal. Would like to do A&S classes, bardic, and moot. These would happen in 10x20s with walls. This allows for a plan in case of weather.

This would be with the same parks dept and ranger as lynx hollow. They are excited.

There is a concern about doing moot and the tourney on the same day. Moot has been done online before. It may be very possible. It is also possible to do moot at an alternate location locally.

If we do moot on a second day, offering crash space in the Barony would be preferred. With the lead-time, this becomes more doable. Ample parking is available at the site.

We may be able to request camping but this is not a camping site. We can ask and see what the answer is
